Las Vegas Convention Center Cannabis/ CBD/ THC Policies

Cannabis/THC/ Hemp

No cannabis/ THC/ Hemp products, including flowers, seeds, concentrates, topicals, or edibles, may be sold, displayed, or distributed, including as free samples, at the LVCC. Smoking or consuming cannabis products, THC, or hemp at the LVCC is strictly prohibited and violators will be trespassed from the LVCC property. Event management will actively monitor and prohibit the use, sale, display, or distribution of cannabis/ THC/ Hemp products at the LVCC by its exhibitors and show attendees.

CBD (Cannabidiol)

No edible CBD products may be sold or distributed at the LVCC, including as free samples, regardless of the THC concentration of the products. Non-edible CBD products, such as oils and topicals, may not be sold at the LVCC but may be distributed or provided as free samples on the condition that the product is not adulterated or misbranded in any way. Smoking CBD products at the LVCC is strictly prohibited and violators will be trespassed from the LVCC property.

Nonsmoking Policy

There is no smoking within the building, within 25 feet of any entrance, and there will be signage outside of every entrance with the no-smoking policy. Electronic cigarettes, electronic vaping devices, personal vaporizers, etc., are **NOT permitted within the facility.**

Recently signed into law, Senate Bill 49 formally designates Delta-7, Delta-8, Delta-10 and any other structural, optical, or geometric isomers of Delta-9 as THC which is a Schedule I controlled substance under the State's Administrative Code. These substances are not allowed in the Las Vegas Convention Center.
